
Since the launch of our digital presence in May, the momentum surrounding TMC has continued to build at a progressive and exciting pace. As well as launching our in-house program in August, we have presented at education conference's at Murdoch University as well as the Catholic Education office. Perth Modern School invited us to engage with their year 11 and 10 cohorts, and we will meet with year nine students at Santa Maria College in November. Various programs are currently being negotiated with other prestigious colleges and organisations for 2018 also.

One of our greatest achievements thus far has been the establishment of a strong sense of community for young people living in East Fremantle. Whilst our aim is to welcome students from various areas to establish a balanced collective, connecting young people who live locally, to each other has highlighted the importance of community, especially in 2017. 
